 Include at least one (1) of these instructional techniques (Direct Instruction, Differentiated Instruction, Multisensory Teaching, Task Analysis, Error Analysis, Peer and Class wide Peer Tutoring) in your presentation. Please feel free to select any other appropriate technique.
