 - i) Write two (2) objectives that target problem solving in two of the three domains. **2 marks**
 - ii) Construct a performance task that measures the two objectives.

- B. i) Two members of the group will design a checklist that can be used as an assessment instrument. **5 marks**
 - ii) The other two group members will design a rubric that can be used as an assessment instrument. **5 marks**
- C. i) Administer the performance task then use the two instruments to assess the performance of **four (4)** students.
 - ii) Reflect on the administration and scoring of the performance task.

ASSIGNMENT 2

- A. This is a collaborative task that requires you to select a topic then prepare assessment tasks to examine the competence of diverse learners in two of the following categories:

 - a) Form groups of **3 4** members.
 - b) **Select** a topic from the curriculum that is being used to teach your subject to students in Jamaican schools.
 - c) In light of the topic, select a general objective and a related specific objective.
 - d) Write a profile of your assessees.
 - e) Develop *two* different assessment tasks (1 for each of the 2 categories that you have chosen from section **A** above).
 - f) Justify each assessment task.

ASSIGNMENT 3

Collaborative group task – groups of 4-5 students (Provide evidence of collaboration to indicate that each person is able to apply relevant skills.)

- 1. Based on **Unit 3** of this course, develop a **Table of Specification (T.O.S.)** for a summative test which is to be used to determine another group's understanding of concepts in the unit.
- 2. Use the **T.O.S.** to design a comprehensive test, which should include at least **two** appropriate 'selected response' and **two** 'constructed response' item formats.
- 3. After administering the test:
 - a) Calculate and interpret the **facility indices** and the **discrimination indices** for a sample of **(3) three** selected response items. **NB**: ensure that you include all calculations such as the mean and ranking.
 - b) Calculate the **mean score** and the **standard deviation** for the test then **interpret** students' performance.
 - c) Design a simple report card to convey the following:accomplishment, challenges (if observed) and recommendations for
 improvement. Include a section for each assessee's response. Allow the
 assessee to respond in writing.
 - d) Prepare a **detailed** reflection on the level of:
 - i) preparedness of the students
 - ii) organisation of the physical space
