- 3. 1 Puzzle (e.g. Puzzlemaker <u>www.puzzlemaker.com</u>)
- 4. 1 Game
- 5. Comic Strip (<u>www.pixton.com</u> & <u>www.toondoo.com</u>
- 6. Audio Recording (e.g. Audacity, Sound Recorder)
- 7. Video Recording (Movie Maker, Photo Story)

You are required to:

- 1. **Submit a document** of no more than **four (4) pages** clearly outlining the contents and the tools to be used in presenting the lesson. Do this by:
 - Specifying the users e.g. Grade, Age, Learning Needs
 - Stating the learning objectives, based on the topic
 - Explaining how and when each tool will be used
 - Outlining clear directions for effective use of each tool included

You should also document the collaborative effort of each member of the group.

2. Present your Multimedia Kit/Portfolio for <u>NO MORE</u> than **30 minutes** (observing the guidelines for the use of various media in the classroom).

NB: Each member of the group should be prepared to present any item in the portfolio that they may be called upon by the facilitator to present.

3. Submit all the files of your Multimedia Portfolio on a CD.
